




#### LOCATION




#### AVERAGE AGE: 64



# PHARMACY PARTNERSHIPS

At Faith Community Pharmacy, our ability to serve patients depends on strong collaborations with organizations that share our mission of increasing access to essential medications. Through these partnerships, we are able to secure life-changing treatments that would otherwise be out of reach for many in our community. Whether through innovative donation programs or alliances with national organizations, each relationship plays a vital role in expanding our inventory and ensuring that costly, high-demand medications make their way to those who need them most.

### **Americares:**

One of our most impactful partnerships is with Americares, a nonprofit organization dedicated to improving access to health care for people in need. Americares works with free and charitable clinics across the country, connecting them with donated medications and supplies from U.S. manufacturers. Through this partnership, we receive vital prescriptions that would otherwise be far too costly for our pharmacy to obtain. For example, thanks to Americares and their collaboration with Lilly, we are able to stock life-saving insulins and other injectable diabetic medications—providing hundreds of thousands of dollars worth of medicine to our patients every month. This relationship helps us ensure that our neighbors with chronic conditions have consistent access to the treatments they depend on.

### **Medication Repository Program:**

Through Kentucky's Medication Repository Program, we are able to give new life to unused prescriptions that would otherwise be discarded. Partner nursing homes across the state send us medications that meet strict storage and safety standards. Once they arrive, our staff and volunteers carefully sort, inspect, and add them to our inventory. This effort has brought significant savings to our patients by making costly medications—like Eliquis and several oral diabetic treatments—available free of charge. To date, more than half a million dollars worth of medications have reached our shelves through this program. While the process requires a great deal of hands-on work, the dedication of our volunteers and the support of our partners, including Gateway Community College, make it possible to transform what might have been waste into life-changing care for our community.
